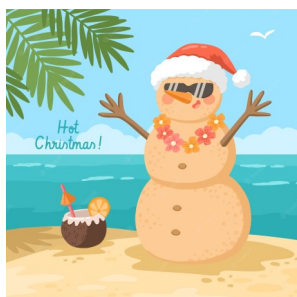

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- **DROP-OFF:** 7am – 8am (**we will not accept participants earlier than 7:00 am**) and **PICK-UP:** 4:30pm-5:30pm- If you will be dropping off or picking up your child(ren) outside of the times listed above, please notify us at **808-286-9870** so we can meet you curbside.
- **Drop-Off/Pick -Up Locations:** Teen Center right next to Welcome Center.
- Please call 808-286-9870 by 9:00am if your child is not coming to the program or arriving late.
- Late Pick-Up Fees are charge to account. \$5.00 for every 15 minutes.
- 100% ID CHECKS – For SAFETY purposes, please have your ID ready to present when picking up your child(ren).
- Please pack 4 snacks– two for AM and two for PM . We are a NUT-FREE program, please do not pack snacks containing nut products.
- Please send your child(ren) with a reusable water bottle.
- **December 25, 2023 and January 1, 2024: NO PROGRAM!**

BEHAVIOR POLICY

If youth participants displays inappropriate conducts within Program time such as but not limited to:

Intent to cause physical harm
Bullying
Inappropriate physical contact with other participants
Disrespectful/Contemptible Behavior towards staff and other participants

Failing to comply to Site/Branch rules can result to a Write up "Behavior Notification", suspension, or termination (with no refund) from program depending on the severity/frequency of the behavior.

Consequences will be determined after a thorough investigation and assessment from the Site Coordinators, Youth Program Directors, and Executive Directors. We ask all Families/Guardians to reinforce expected behavior during program with youth participants especially after a report from a Youth Program Staff.

We highly encourage the children not to bring personal items including the following:

- Trading cards (Pokemon, Yu Gi Oh, pogs, etc.)
- Electronic devices (iPod/tablets, Nintendo Switch, MP3 players, cellular phones)
- Toys of any kind

If a weapon or any form of substance of any type is found on a child, a Youth staff will remove the item immediately and notify the participants parents/guardians. If a child brings any of the other items listed above, the staff will take them away and store these items in a secure area until they can be returned via the child's parents/guardians.

SEA LIFE PARK FIELD TRIP DEC.28,2023

Please have youth participants **report at the Kalihi YMCA Branch by 8:45 AM** and are expected to return by 3:30 PM. Any youths that report after the scheduled time may result in missing the Bus Pick-Up therefore will have to be sent home since no staff will be available to provide supervision. Shoes must be worn at the field trip at all times, no Crocs, slippers, or sandals. Youths should wear comfortable and breathable clothes. If a student reports to the program with the wrong attire they will be sent home and not participate in the Field Trip.

Lunch will be provided for the participants, but it is also acceptable to pack the students additional food. Youth Participants should bring a refillable water bottle.
